

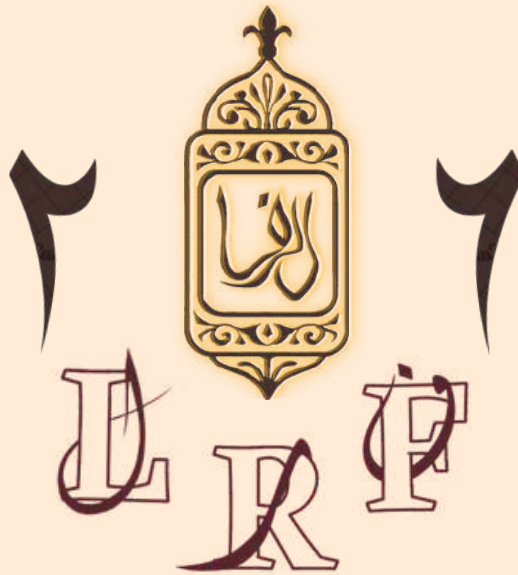

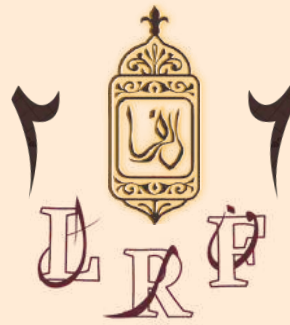

WHAT IS LRF?



LUMS Religious Festival (LRF) is the flagship event of the LUMS Religious Society. It aims to foster religious identity among young people and facilitate intellectual religious discourse, thereby precipitating a paradigm shift towards a more inclusive, accepting, and diverse society.

The event itself features multiple competitions based on religion: **entrepreneurship** targeting the religious audience, **debate** on global matters related to religion, **research** contrasting Islamic Laws with secular laws and what context Islamic laws exist in, even **calligraphy** expressing religion. This is in addition to speaker sessions from globally recognised scholars, solidarity initiatives, entertaining activities, and community service projects.

In short, LRF inspires **faith in the youth, cultivates strong character, and promotes meaningful engagement with religion** in the country.





VISION



The topic of religion is often neglected in large scale student-organized events in the collegiate sphere, and religious boundaries valued by many students, often overlooked. Over time, as a consequence of placing these boundaries on priority, such students remain bereft of the invaluable growth opportunities these events place on offer.

In the coming years, our vision for the LUMS Religious Festival is to pioneer an initiative which, while surpassing the transformative and professional experiences disseminated by other large-scale events, allows students who value religious boundaries to immerse themselves in these experiences, and think critically about the role of religion in contemporary society, growing intellectually, spiritually, and personally.

To achieve our vision, we aim to curate an event which offers a comprehensive list of avenues for engagement - aligning with the theme of religion as encompassing all facets of life. Through the combination of religious discourse with mainstream academia in all avenues, we aim to test delegates with the unique challenges that arise from this integration, placing emphasis on improvisation and resourcefulness in dealing with real word case studies and applied scenarios.

TAJALLI - E - KHAT - O - RANG (Calligraphy)

Tajalli-e-Khat-o-Rang celebrates spirituality through calligraphy, where each stroke and color reflects divine beauty. It connects creativity with faith through creating, learning, and appreciating Islamic art. With competitions, live sketching, and workshops, it revives traditional calligraphy while giving students a hands-on space to express their artistic and spiritual sides.

SAREER - E - KHAMA (Research)

Sareer-e-Khama (The sound of the pen) is LUMS Religious Festival's (LRF) hallmark research-based competition. The event is meant to foster the love of research in participants and encourage them to think critically regarding the contemporary issues they will cover, spanning a wide array of topics regarding religious thought. All of this must be done under the high standard of academic rigor, and an ethical, meaningful, research-based approach is expected from all in their submissions and presentations.

Maximum Number of Delegates per Team: 3

TAJDEED - E - TIJARAT (Entrepreneurship)

Tajdeed-e-Tijarat is a three-day entrepreneurial event that reconnects students with innovation and commerce by linking aspiring entrepreneurs with experienced investors. It promotes creativity, business insight, and mentorship through an expert workshop, a pitching round, and a finale with one-on-one investor mentorship. It comprises three main rounds: an expert-led training workshop, an elimination pitching round, and a grand finale featuring one-on-one mentorship sessions with leading investors. (Tentative)

Maximum Delegates per Delegation: 3

HUJJAT - E - HAQ (MUN)

In its first edition, LRF hosted declamation contests ending in a British Parliamentary-style Grand Finale, all centered on Palestinian resistance and survival under Israeli occupation supported by imperial powers. The second edition introduced an OIC Council Conference (MUN), led by experienced Chairs who had represented LUMS at HNMUN, with an agenda focused on exploring a Unified Islamic Bloc similar to the EU for trade, defense, and collective policy coordination.

TASVEER - E - TAJALLI (Content Creation)

"Tasveer-e-Tajalli" offers participants a platform to express their creative and spiritual ideas through photography and videography. The event has two rounds: Making Pictures Speak, where participants tell a story through images, and a short film round based on a specific spiritual theme. Both rounds include unique restrictions and twists to spark creativity. Together, they ensure that purpose and creativity blend in an inspiring way.

FEHM-E-ISLAM (QUIZ)

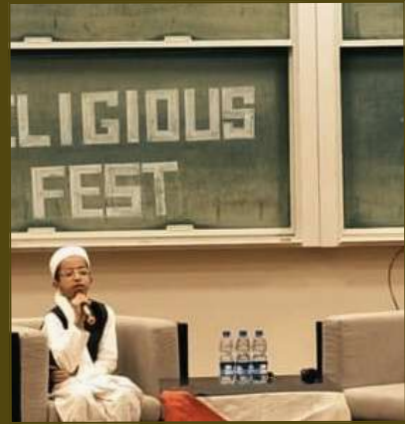
This exciting quiz category goes beyond the traditional question-and-answer style, offering a more engaging and immersive experience. Participants will face thought-provoking challenges that uncover the depth of Islamic teachings, highlighting their meaning and relevance in everyday life. This time around, several rounds are modelled after popular game shows, blending knowledge with entertainment to make sure that participants have a memorable time.

Maximum Number of Delegates per Team: 3

MIZMAAR - E - DAWOOD (Naat & Qirat)

Mizmaar-e-Dawood is where emotion, rhythm, and words come together, creating a space for every unique voice to be heard. It celebrates spirit and soul through themes that deepen emotional reflection and connection. The event has two stages: Preliminary Rounds with greater creative freedom, followed by Final Rounds with more challenging criteria. Though simple and straightforward, it still offers ample room for creativity and meaningful expression.

Alongside this, a marquee speaker session with a nationally or internationally acclaimed figure will invite participants into an honest, thought-provoking conversation on what faith truly entails, how it is perceived today and how it can be understood with clarity, purpose and sincerity.

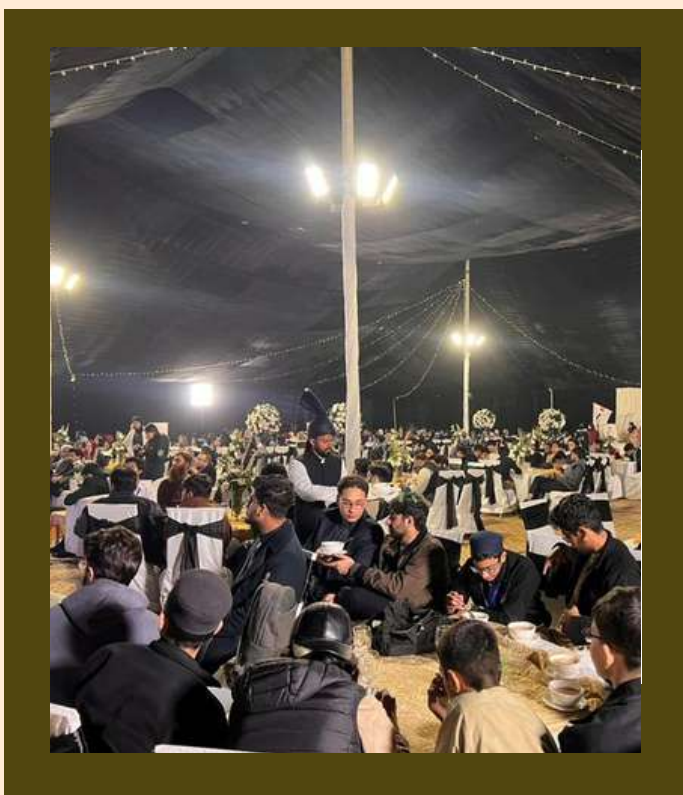
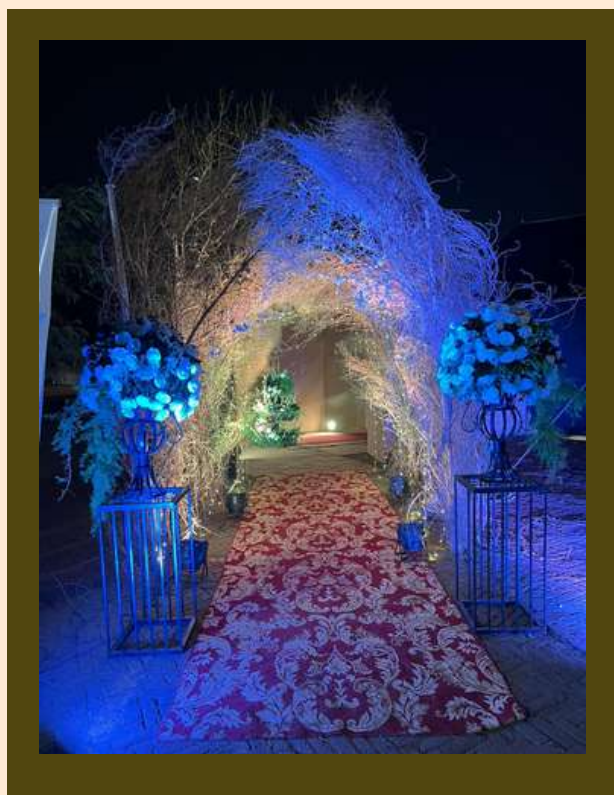
Day 03

EVENT STRUCTURE

Campus Ambassador Perks:

- If the 3 and more teams are being brought in, the delegation fee is waived off completely for each team while the campus ambassador will be receiving a shield.
- If teams brought by one ambassador reaches the number greater than 5, we would be awarding the ambassador with Shield along with an exclusive LRF shirt.

Methodology

- **Individual Events:** Each team member must take part in one individual event. Example: If a team has 5 members, all 5 must register for exactly one of the three available individual categories.
- **Team Events:** Each team may compete in up to three team events. However, they must select at least one event from Rawayaat-e-Ilm and one from Tajdeed-o-Takhliq. Teams are free to decide how to divide their members across the team events they select.
- **Clash of Champions:** This is a qualification-based event.
- Only the Winners and Runners-up from the seven individual and team events will qualify. The Clash will include a mix of individual tasks and group activities.
- Delegation from same schools have to register under different team names to avoid any confusion like (Lums Team A, Lums Team B and so on).
