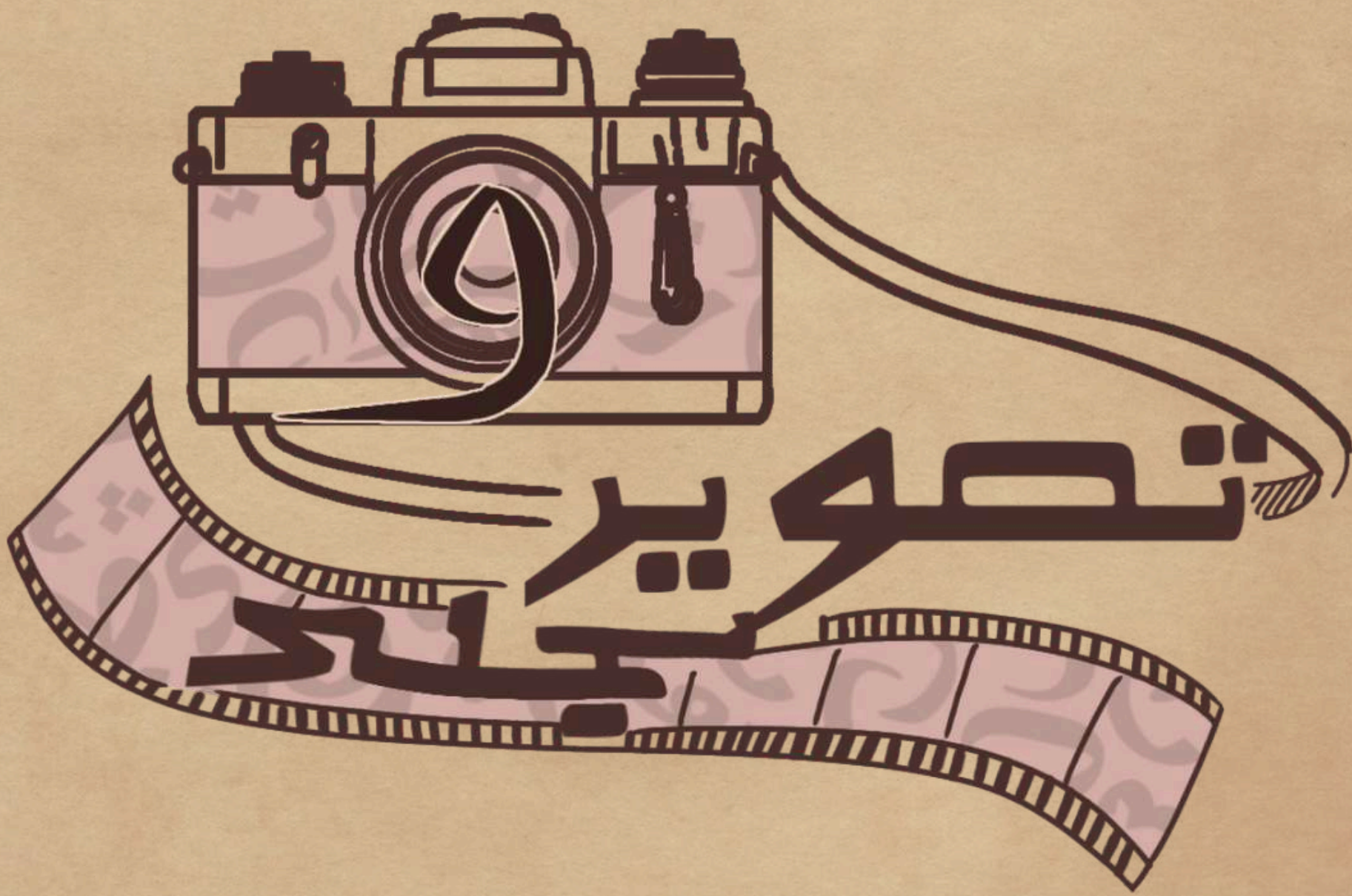

INTRODUCTION

A heartfelt welcome to the LUMS Religious Festival, a realm where spirituality, creativity, and passion converge. This guide will introduce you to the essentials of Tasveer-e-Tajjali, outline and the structure of its rounds, and give you a clear sense of what to expect throughout the experience.

OVERVIEW

Tasveer-e-Tajalli is a three-day visual storytelling competition that celebrates photography and videography as mediums of spiritual and reflective expression. This category is splitted into two rounds. Participants are evaluated through a points-based system, and the team with the highest cumulative score across both rounds will be crowned the winner.

THE STILL FRAME

Round 1: Photography round

This round invites photography enthusiasts to capture moments through a spiritual lens, blending technical skill with meaningful storytelling. Participants will be judged on their ability to visually communicate depth, emotion, and reflection. Participants will receive a list of spiritual themes that will serve as the foundation for their work. All essential details will be revealed on the day of event.

Submission Protocol:

Teams must upload their photographs to a Google Drive folder named after their team. The corresponding link will be shared.

Equipment:

Participants are required to bring their own recording devices, such as cameras or smartphones.

GENERAL JUDGING CRITERIA

Relevance to theme - 20%:

The submission must clearly align with the assigned theme.

Incorporation of restrictions - 10%:

Marks will reflect how well the participant has included any given restriction or twist.

Adherence to time - 10%:

Late submissions or exceeding time limits may lead to deduction, as per the policy.

Coherence and storytelling - 20%:

We'll check how smoothly the photos connect to form a story or convey a clear message (if there is any).

Creativity and originality - 30%:

We'll look for unique, imaginative ideas that show a fresh or personal perspective.

Photography skills - 10%:

The quality of the pictures and overall photography technique.

THE MOVING CANVAS

Round 2: Video Submission

In this round, teams will have to do a video submission. This round invites participants to translate one of the given poetic themes into visuals where words fade into imagery, meanings deepen and visuals become a space for reflection. The focus is on interpretation rather than direct illustration. All essential details will be revealed on the day of event.

Submission format:

MP4 format with a minimum of 720p resolution

Equipment:

Participants are required to bring their own recording devices, such as cameras or smartphones and are expected to have their editing softwares ready.

GENERAL JUDGING CRITERIA

Relevance to Theme – 25%

Does the story clearly match the chosen theme?

Timing – 15%

Does the film stay and submitted within the allotted time?

Storytelling & Flow – 20%

Do the scenes connect smoothly to tell a clear message.

Creativity & Originality – 30%

Is the idea fresh, unique, and imaginative.

Acting & Expression – 10%

Are the performances engaging and expressive?
